

















Ethiopia is one of the countries with the most ancient official religion as early as in the 4th century A.D. It is documented in written sources: manuscripts in posses to early Middle Ages, have been estimated to number

Only a minor part of these archives have so far receive microfilmed or digitalized, and only those that have co well protected. A great part of this unique heritage is complete disappearance.
