





*Gädl* of Saint Cyricus and  
of his mother Julitta, who  
finished their lives during  
the time of King  
Alexander (*’Eskəndros*)  
for the name of Christ,  
was completed. May their  
prayer and their blessing  
be with their children:  
Tä<sup>c</sup>areyännä <sup>o</sup>Egzi<sup>o</sup> with  
Zä-Mäl<sup>p</sup>ak and with all of  
us, children of this place,  
and with its scribe, sinner  
and impious, Zä-Wäldä  
Maryam. For ever and  
ever, amen».














