HINDI INTENSIVE COURSE 01.08. – 19.08.2023

Intermediate and advanced level

The courses are aimed at intermediate and advanced level participants. Our main focus is on communicative language use.

Goals of the Courses

Intermediate Level

- Mastery and expansion of the acquired vocabulary
- Internalizing and expanding the grammatical knowledge
- Reading and understanding easy to semi-difficult texts
- Enhance the ability to use the learned grammar and vocabulary in conversation
- > Enhance the ability to express yourself confidently and easily in everyday life
- Enhancing listening comprehension

Advanced Level

- Communicate effectively in most daily practical and social situations on a concrete and abstract level;
- Having formal and informal discussions related to problem solving and decision making;
- ➤ Have concrete oral and written discussions on complex topics and present a detailed analysis or comparison;
- With improved ability to respond appropriately to the level of formality of social interaction;
- Answer more complex indirect questions about personal experience and general knowledge;
- Explain the most important ideas, keywords and details about a text;
- Mastery of complex text structures and spelling;
- The ability to understand and critically evaluate scriptures that reflect multicultural images and perspectives;
- Use and understand an expanded inventory of specific and general idioms;
- The ability to read critically about ideas and topics, including multicultural perspectives; Analyze and synthesize information;
- The ability to analyze the message, audience, language choice, tone, purpose and author's ethos in a selected text;
- The ability to recognize logical errors, biased language, idioms, slang, jargon and tone;
- > The ability to develop ideas with logical support, including the use of informed opinions, facts and their interpretations;

Important Notes

 At the end of the course, a written exam will be conducted in each course. Apart from classroom teaching the intensive course also includes and encourages extracurricular language

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and culture related activities. Upon successful exam, ten credit points will be awarded in

each course.

We reserve the right to split a class into two groups - A and B - according to the level and

number of participants, if required.

The decision of accepting or rejecting the application of a participant solely lies with the

organizer(s).

o Since more and more participants from non-German-speaking countries are showing their

deep interest in our Hindi Intensive Courses, we reserve the right to hold the classes in Eng-

lish, if needed.

o The minimum required number of participants for a course is 10 and the maximum number

of participants in each class preferably shall not exceed 16 persons.

o As the course will be held in hybrid mode the zoom link will be shared with the participant

only after a successful registration.

Teaching Material

For both the intermediate and advanced-level courses, we mainly use our own teaching materials

that will be distributed in the classes on the first day and during the classes. Teaching material for readings tasks and analysis consists of excerpts from novels, newspapers, magazines, and short

stories.

Registration

The course fees for non-students is **495** Euros and for external students and pupils the course fees is **385** Euros. Registrations done after 30th June 2023 will have to pay the increased fees by 20 percent.
