RAMAYDA AKMAL, born in Cilacap on 5 May 1987, was named as an *Emerging Writer* at the *Ubud Writers and Readers Festival 2013* in Bali, Indonesia. Her notable works: *Jatisaba* (novel, 2011) won the Jakarta Arts Council Novel Writing Competition 2010; *Lengkingan Viola Desingan Peluru* (short stories, 2012) won the Best Literary Work 2012 of Balai Bahasa Yogyakarta; *Tango & Sadimin* (novel, 2019) won the UNNES International Novel Writing Contest 2017 and enlisted as one of five top candidates to receive the national literary award *Kusala Sastra Khatulistiwa 2019*.
