


SOUTHEAST ASIA VINTAGE MOVIES

INDIO NACIONAL (Philippines / 2005)

(Director: Raya Martin, 96 Min., silent film)



A Filipino Film directed by Raya Martin (2005). Duration: 1h36. One of the most accurate recreations of the silent film aesthetic since the arrival of talkies, "A Short Film About the Indio Nacional (or the Prolonged Sorrow of Filipinos)" a tripartite tale of the burgeoning sense of freedom in the Philippines in the 1890s. Raya Martin's beautiful praise of the common man, or "indio," of the period is a fascinating work that intermittently rewards patience and confirms Martin's place as a talent to watch. Mimicking early silent films, Independencia creates a lush metaphor that plays with cinematic illusions and the cultural and mythical history of the Philippines.
