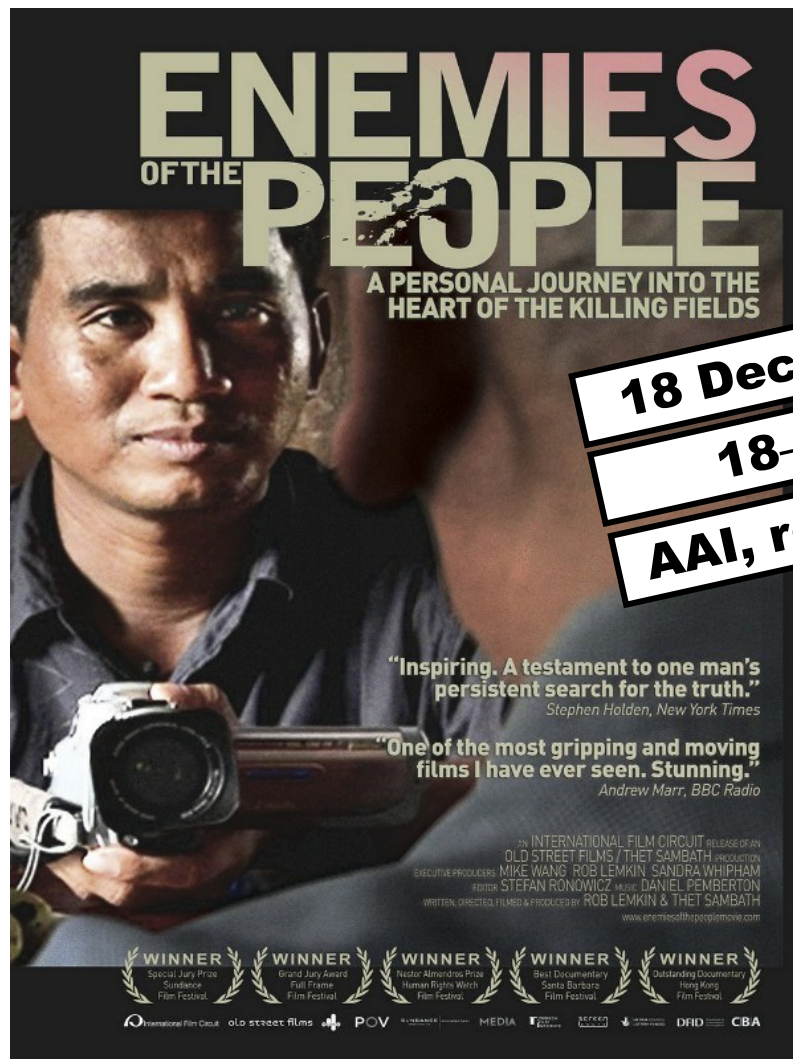


MOVIE SCREENING



Enemies of the People is a British/Cambodian documentary film written and directed by Rob Lemkin and Thet Sambath. The film depicts the ten-year quest of co-director Thet Sambath to find the truth about the mass killings during the Khmer Rouge regime of Democratic Kampuchea between 1975 and 1979.

Thet Sambath who lost his parents and one brother during one of the most radical and violent communist revolutions decided to seek confessions from former Khmer Rouge officials at all levels to understand why over one million Cambodians died in the Killing Fields.

Over three years Sambath visited Nuon Chea and earned the trust of "Brother Number Two". Finally, Nuon Chea was willing to talk about his role in the Killing Fields.

This documentary is one of the most harrowing and compelling documentaries of our time.
