Synopsis

Ahmet O. Evin (B.A. Columbia University, 1966; Ph.D. 1973) has been affiliated with Sabancı University since the beginning in 1995 of the University's design process. He has served as the founding dean of its Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences (1997-2001), has taken part in the design of the Istanbul Policy Center, and has been serving on its Executive Board since the Center's establishment in 2001. In autumn 2011 he was named Jean Monnet Chair (ad personam) of European Policy Studies and continues to teach Political Science at Sabancı University.

In 2004-2005 he served as Alexander Onassis Senior Fellow at Eliamep (Hellenic Foundation for European and Foreign Policy, Athens); in 2008 he was elected Senior Fellow of the Transatlantic Academy, Washington, DC, where he was in residence in 2009-2010 and concurrently appointed as senior scholar at the Johns Hopkins University, SAIS. In 2016 he was elected to the advisory board of the Institute of Advanced Studies Köszeg, where he also serves as a senior research fellow.

He has authored or edited over 12 volumes on politics, culture, and development.
